**1. Technical Assistant -One**

The selected candidates will work (under supervision) in different modules of the testing laboratory and linked biorepository, based on requirements. Responsibilities include (but are not limited to): receipt and documentation of donor samples (NPS/OPS swabs, saliva, blood, feces, etc.), aliquoting, processing and testing of samples for COVID-19, maintaining database of testing results and inventory of archived samples, and assisting with the distribution of samples for approved projects. The COVID-19 laboratory has a 6-day week. The initial appointment is for one year, renewable depending on performance review and availability of funding.

BSc/ Three-year diploma in Engineering and Technology: 20,000/- + 24% HRA

Preference will be given to applicants with experience in R&D diagnostic laboratories in the clinical or industry setting and previous experience working with databases and excel spreadsheets
